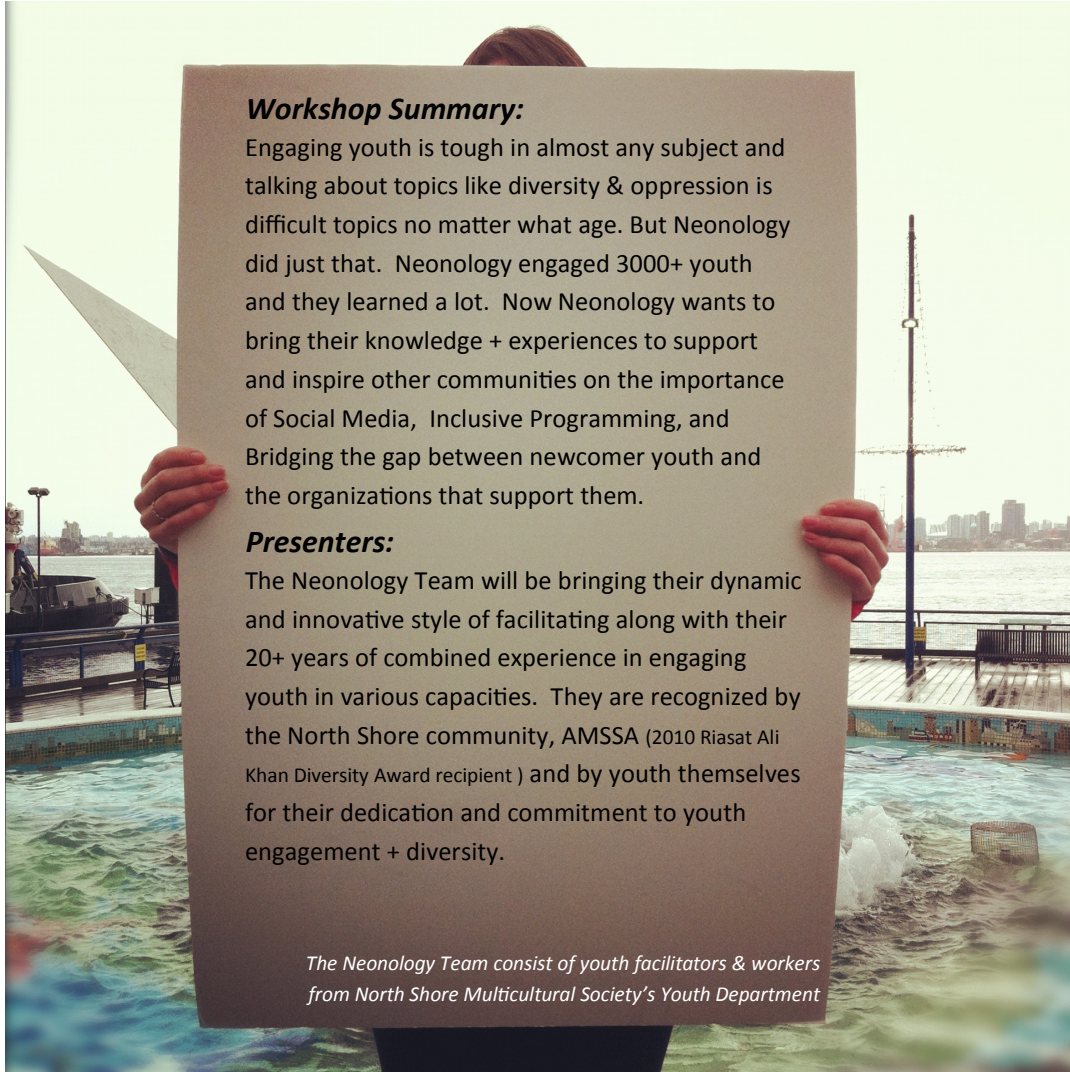
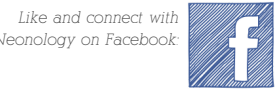
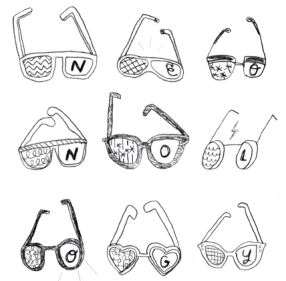


# The Neonology Legacy
