The Wonder of Learning exhibit from Reggio Emilia is at the River Market in New Westminster July - December, 2012.

The overarching theme for professional development in association with the Wonder of Learning exhibit is "Encounters with the Pedagogical Project of Reggio Emilia: Collaborations, Complexities, and Connections." Each of three events will take up the idea of collaborations, complexities, and connections.

The series begins with Dr. Carla Rinaldi, President of Reggio Children, opening the exhibit. A fundraising dinner and talk will take place at La Perla Ballroom on July 17. Dr. Rinaldi will talk about the value of Collaborations arising out of encounters with Reggio Emilia. This will be followed by a Gala Opening Celebration on July 18.

Complexities, a conference co-hosted by The Vancouver Reggio Consortium, Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House, CAYC, and NAREA, will coincide with the BC Provincial Professional Development Day October 19/20. The theme for this conference is "Embracing Complexity in the Daily Life of the School: The Learning Process Through the Process of Observation, Interpretation, and

Documentation." Featured speakers will be two educators from Reggio Emilia.

Our series concludes with a final conference, Connections. Featured keynote speakers will be Dr. Lella Gandini, primary author of the Reggio Emilia experience, and Dr. Stefania Giamminuti, former intern in the schools of Reggio Emilia. November 30/December 1.
