In continuity with the previous exhibition, *The Hundred Languages of Children*, the aim is to reconfirm the values at the heart of the Reggio Emilia educational philosophy. The exhibition speaks to all those involved in schooling, and to all members of the general public who believe that safeguarding educational processes and their evolution is of fundamental importance for society.

The exhibit is aimed at an adult audience, although children are welcome. There are a variety of interactive elements for children to engage with.
