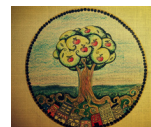

Harvest **BOX** Options

Through bulk purchases, we are able to provide more quality fresh produce and fruit, for your purchasing dollar, compared to the average supermarket. Our Harvest Boxes contain a variety of fresh produce and fruit (about 10 pounds) with as much as possible sourced locally to support BC farmers. Our boxes are 100% post-consumer recycled cardboard and contain an informative free monthly newsletter filled with nutritional facts, information and recipes.

The program offers the three box choices below, and there are no limits to the number of boxes that you can purchase.

Harvest **ValueBox** \$8.00

- Designed to make vegetables and fruit more affordable
- Contains a variety of fresh vegetables and fruit
- Produce is sourced locally, as much as possible, but includes imported produce when not locally available

Harvest **LocalBox** \$15.00

- Contains local BC vegetables and fruit
- Supports local growers and sustainable agricultural methods

Harvest **BOGOBox** \$15.00

- Your BOGO purchase gets you a Harvest Value Box and donates a Harvest Value Box to individuals or families in need!
- Contains several varieties of fresh vegetables and fruit
- Produce is sourced locally, as much as possible, but includes imported produce when not locally available
